How practicing piano is like following GPS



1

In our lesson time, we always "map out" a piece before playing it. We look over each hand individually, noticing the key signature, hand position, intervals, etc., as well as anything unexpected such as changing hand positions. And it's a good idea to do this when you're practicing as well, at least for the first few days.

Just like when you pull up GPS directions for somewhere you're going. I would think that like me, you read over the entire directions before beginning your journey. It's the same with a new piece. Before beginning your "journey" of playing the piece, look over the piece first to see "where you're going." This helps minimize any surprises along the way. It also helps you avoid pausing to figure out what comes next, keeping a steady rhythm.

I always like knowing ahead of time if the next turn is going to be left or right, allowing me to be in the correct lane in plenty of time. Likewise, in playing music, knowing where something different is coming up ahead of time lets you be prepared for it.

We'll continue this challenge through February, so there's still time to improve your time for your level and maybe even win a gift card! More details are in the One Minute Club sheet in your student's music folder.


Winter Performance
